EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS

All families have received a copy of **"2020/2021 Year-at-a-Glance"** which indicates holidays, in-service, administration days, and early dismissal days for the school year. These days are printed on the monthly school calendar and newsletter available on the School's website: <u>www.stgerardschool.net</u> Please mark the dates at home to remind yourself when your child will be dismissed early to ensure they have a ride at 2:25 p.m. Early dismissal days are scheduled to provide time for school personnel to attend Staff Meetings. Teachers/Staff are <u>not</u> available to supervise students after 2:30 p.m. on these days. Students are not permitted to wait unsupervised for their ride – and students not picked up by 2:30 will be sent to the *After School Program* (a service Parents **will be** charged for).

<u>DO NOT</u> INSTRUCT YOUR CHILD TO PHONE TO REMIND, OR ARRANGE RIDES ON EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS. TRANSPORTATION ARRANGEMENTS, ETC. SHOULD BE MADE IN ADVANCE. THE PHONE IN THE SCHOOL OFFICE IS FOR <u>EMERGENCY</u> USE ONLY.

We do our best to keep our families informed of all school events.

It is the parent's responsibility to read <u>all</u> school correspondence in a timely manner to ensure they are informed of important announcements/events. Parents should check backpacks/agenda books <u>daily</u> for notes, permission slips, etc. (Ask your child each day if there are any notes sent home from school!) We will be emailing all notes/information that does not require information from families. This way there is less paper transfer between many hands.

Many of our families in past years have chosen to celebrate their child's birthday by generously providing the entire class with cake, treats, and beverages.

The teachers have asked that <u>all</u> birthday celebrations be conducted at venues <u>outside</u> of the school. St. Gerard will continue to recognize our students' birthdays by sending greetings to them during morning announcements, as well as granting them a "N.U.T." Day (<u>No U</u>niform <u>T</u>oday).

SCHOOL FEES

All families are aware of their yearly mandatory school fees, and have been invoiced for such.

Please be aware that all SEPTEMBER fees were due **September 1st**, and should be submitted to the School Office (Activity, Building Improvement, Tuition, School Bus).

If you have not already done so, and in order to keep your account up-to-date, please submit your fees immediately.

(Note: An outstanding **Activity Fee** may hinder your child's participation in Field Trips until fees, which are used to pay for these events, are collected.)

If you have submitted your payments, they will be applied to your account accordingly, and you will receive a receipt.

Reduced Speed Limits in School Zones:

Please remember the reduced speed zone on Talbot Avenue. The reduced speed limit is set at 30 km/hr and in force Monday to Friday from 7:00 - 17:30, in the months of September to June. This has been set out by the City of Winnipeg. You will find signs to indicate the start and end of the reduced speed zone. Please be mindful of this as you drive down Talbot Avenue during the school months. It is for the safety of our children.

A FEW REMINDERS TO PARENTS OF CHILDREN WHO USE THE SCHOOL BUS:

★ Ensure your child is at their stop 5 minutes <u>prior</u> to pick-up time.

We would like to welcome **Ms. Caruk** (Grade 3 Teacher) & **Mrs. Escoto** (Grade 7 Teacher) to our St. Gerard School staff. Please help us in welcoming them to our school community.

The School is again reminding all our families to please follow our "road safety" rules to ensure our children are safely dropped off and picked up from school:

► The lane is **ONE WAY** from Foster to Grey streets during morning drop off and afternoon pick up.

We thank our families for following the signage that indicates the area in front of our back lane door is a "No Stopping / No Drop-Off" area. For the safety of our children – please park in an open parking spot against the gym wall when dropping off or picking up your child. (NOTE: the spots against the school wall that are "numbered" are for STAFF ONLY. As there are minimal spots available for our staff's use, please refrain from parking or stopping in these stalls at any time.)

DO NOT STOP OR PARK YOUR VEHICLE ON OUR NEIGHBOUR'S PROPERTY!

- Many of our families are stopping/parking "hugged" up against the garages/fences situated along the school's back lane. These areas are not school or public property – therefore, our families should be respecting the property of the home owner. Let's practice and encourage "healthy living lifestyles" with our children by walking the short distance!
- ► The 2 handicapped parking spaces located near the gym entrance are to be used by vehicles with designated handicapped stickers only **PLEASE**.
- Please do not park in the School Bus Loading Zone on Foster Street (as indicated on the street signs).

Let's be respectful of each other – as we ask our children to be.
